

RYA POWERBOAT COURSE JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

The date of your RYA Powerboat Level 2 course is coming up. Here is some information that will hopefully answer any questions that you may have.

Your course will start at 0900.

The Course takes place at iPowerboat, Marine Training Centre, Near Kinlochleven, Argyll. PH50 4QN. The training centre has just opened, but we're still to install branding/signs etc. If coming from North Ballachulish, drive towards Kinlochleven, eventually you will pass an island with a layby, the training centre is about 200m further on the road. If driving from Glencoe, drive through the village of Kinlochleven and out the other side. You'll eventually pass over a narrow bridge, the training centre is about 200m further on.

YOU WILL NEED TO BRING:

- ⊗ Waterproofs (we do have a range of clothing if needed)
- ⊗ Warm clothes,
- ⊗ Gloves,
- ⊗ Sea boots/wellies, or waterproof footwear
- ⊗ Passport photograph (for the certification process).

The course is essentially practical and, by visiting a variety of locations, you will have the opportunity of developing your practical skills throughout the course. The course content also includes a number of shore-based lectures covering subjects such as collision regulations, chartwork, meteorology, etc. I also cannot overemphasise that the entire experience is intended to be ENJOYABLE coupled with learning opportunities.

You will need to bring a packed lunch and there will be plenty of tea and coffee available at all times!
